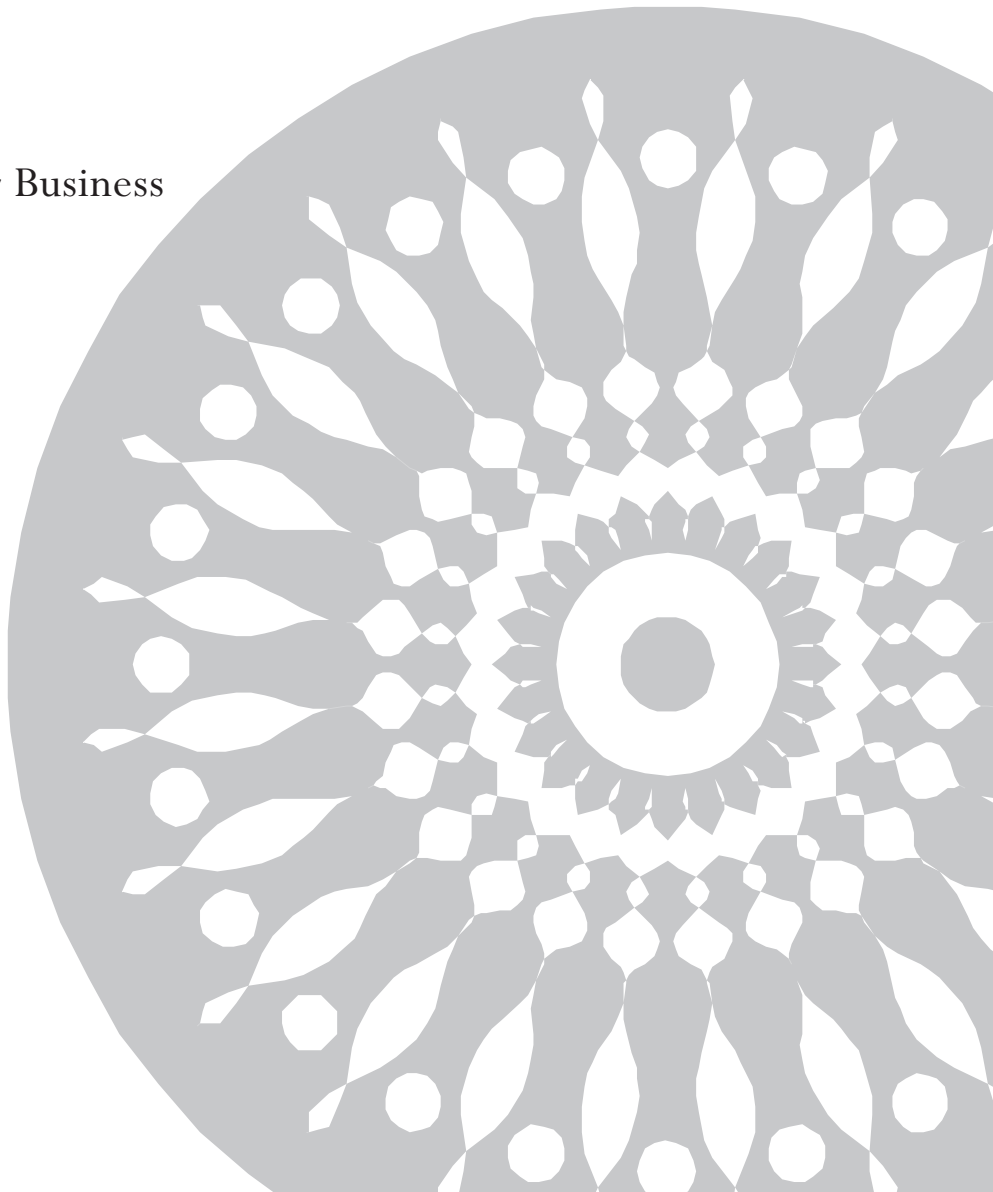


I warmly welcome you to the 2014 Global India Business Meeting and sincerely hope that you will enjoy the discussions.
