

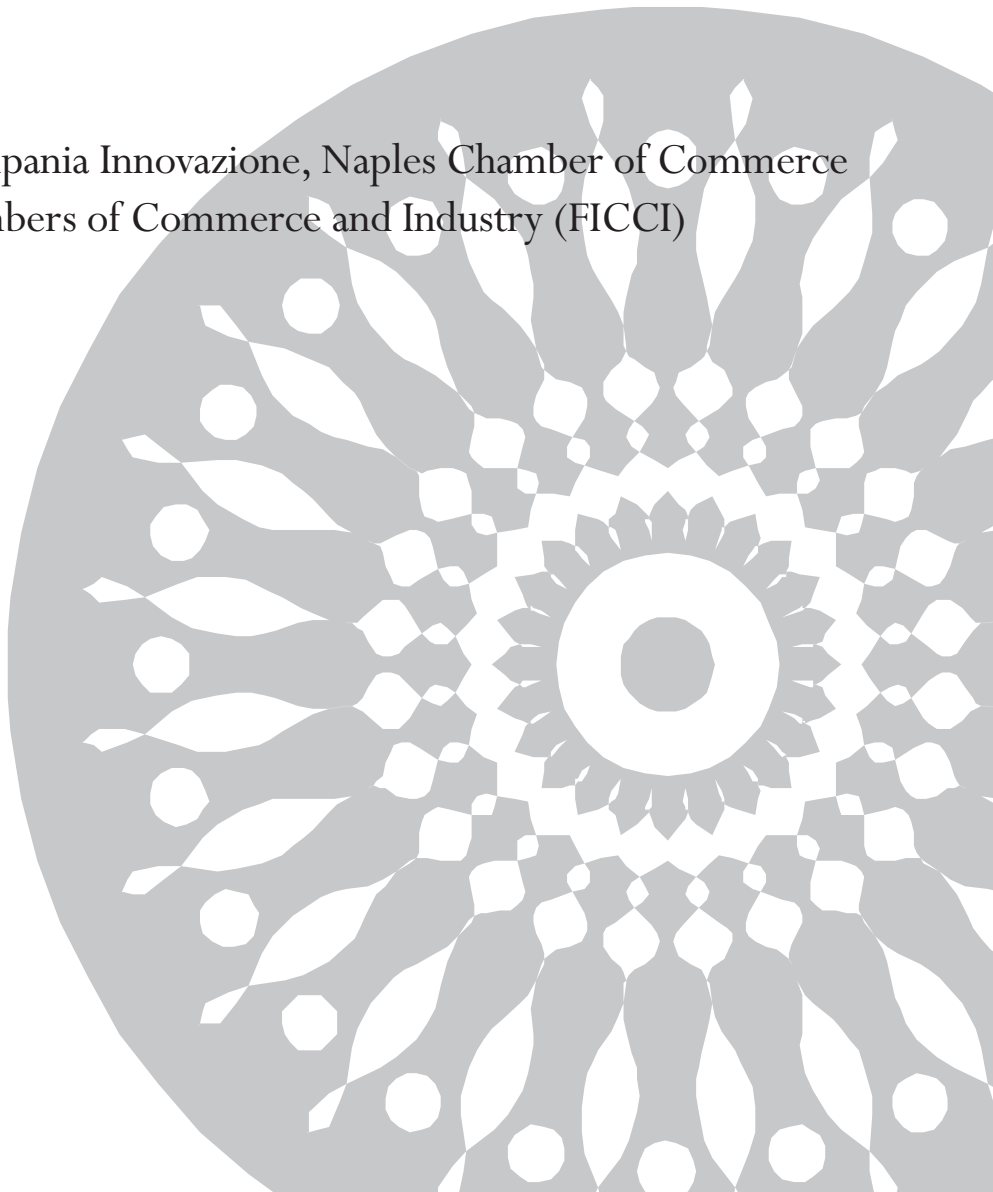

Welcome



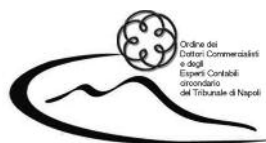
